Whenever possible, she takes classes with Alejandra Martiñan, Gustavo Naveira & Giselle Anne, and Chicho Frumboli & Lucia Mazer.

In just two short years of exceptional dance partnership, **Andrés & Meredith** have emerged as a driving force in nuevo tango – on the cutting edge of ongoing developments and explosive innovations powering this demanding art form. Andrés & Meredith are especially known for their pioneering use of alternative embraces, daring off-axis work, dazzling interweaving legs, and exceptional fluidity.

Gracious and generous in their classes and workshops, **Andrés & Meredith** are blessed with an uncommon ability to probe, understand, analyze and convey the intricacies of tango. They offer beginners and experienced dancers alike a fresh and profound slant on the fundamental principles, essential techniques, and core relationships that anchor and propel each form of the dance – including "traditional" social tango, historic "vintage" tango, progressive "nuevo" tango, and the astounding tangos of tomorrow yet to be named. Whichever style you prefer, and whether in the classroom, at the milonga, or in private lessons, each encounter with Andrés & Meredith inevitably strikes students and fellow dancers as potent, illuminating, and transformative – a rare chance to touch the pure sweet heart of tango, and take your dancing into a whole new realm.

In 2007, Andrés & Meredith will teach in 20 cities on three continents - Europe, North America and South America.
